CONCEPT OF NATCO TRUST

It is with the aim of covering this deficit, Shri Nannapaneni has established NATCO TRUST as the corporate social responsibility arm of NATCO Pharma Ltd, and it is based in Hyderabad. The core areas of interventions are Education, Health, Hygiene, Sanitation, Water, Livelihoods, Farming, Institutional support and need based community Infrastructure. It operates in the vicinity of wherever it has a business presence and the mentor's home district.

CORPORATE APPROACH

Natco Trust has witnessed the transition in the year 2008, as it was being spearheaded by Ms. Swathi, the family member. Emphasis laid on the holistic development of an individual, starting from the birth, through their journey into childhood, adolescence, adulthood and in the latter years of their life inclusive of socio-economic, physical, mental, ecological and spiritual wellbeing and more importantly it transcends the barriers and caters to the holistic requirements and aspirations of the community through their journey of life for healthy and happiness.

We at NATCO endeavour to make a positive contribution to the underprivileged by supporting a wide range of socio-economic demand driven programs including education, health, nutrition, sanitation, hygiene, livelihood, farming, and other community-based initiatives to promote a healthy and happy living.

The program also envisages in supporting and strengthening the government schools and Anganwadi centres in terms of academics as well as the requisite infrastructure

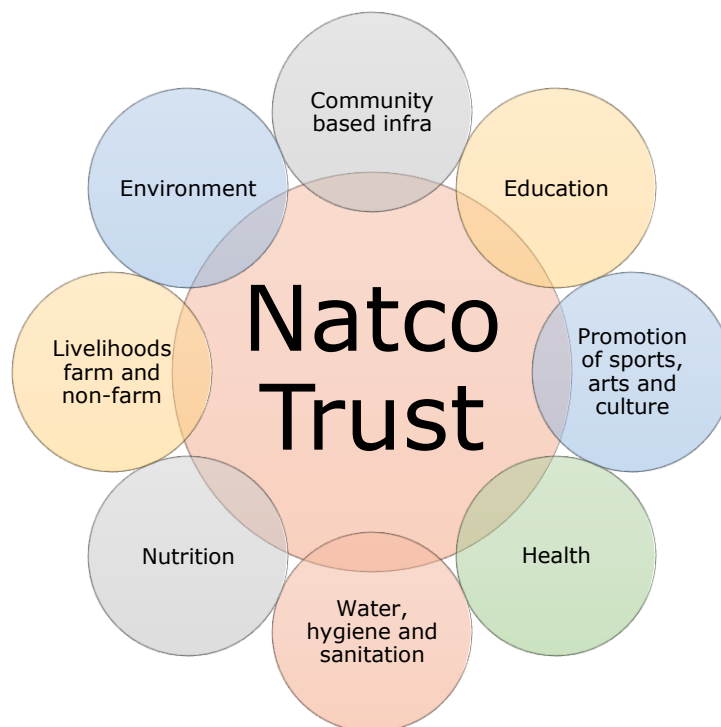
development, providing health related infrastructure as well as medicines and patients counsellors to the government hospitals, community healthcare services through institutional and outreach, extending “Purified potable water of high standards”; Individual Sanitation latrines (ISLs); catering to the needs of pregnant and lactating mothers by supplementing their diet in terms of nutritious food supplements and periodical medical check-ups and health education at the “Nutrition Centres”; and “kitchen Gardens” to promote easily available, unadulterated nutritious food and also promotion of organic farming.

Special care is also being given to “Tiny Tots” at the Anganwadies. School health and hygiene is also being given special care as is the creation of livelihoods by establishing skill based vocational training centres.

AREAS OF OPERATION

Currently Natco Trust operates in 8 districts namely, Ranga Reddy, Nalagonda, Hyderabad, Siddipet, Guntur, Prakasam, Vizianagaram and Visakhapatnam in the states of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh and also some parts of Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu.

Supported 64 Anganwadis, 42 schools, 9 adult literacy centers thus reached 8671 children and 109 women. Institutional support to 3 schools



Under outreach healthcare services - 2 mobile and 2 stand-alone clinics reached 49466 patients in over 100 villages.

Institutional healthcare services in 6 hospitals reached 268902 patients



Reached to 445 mothers with nutritional supplements in 28 villages, 230 deliveries, 151 deliveries at government and 79 at private hospitals



Employees volunteering 913 units of blood donation and 58 covid-19 positive employees donated plasma



Supported 3 states with covid-19 related essentials like PPE kits, medicines, face masks, hand gloves, sanitizers, funds etc, Distributed 10950 meals and over 3000 kits of dry ration to migrant and daily wage laborers. Established isolation ward, 118 employees got benefited. Distribution of face masks, sanitizer and de-sanitizing the targeted villages etc.



Over 18000 people got benefitted from potable water facility in two villages



Reached to 1071 families in 28 villages for kitchen gardens and 116 farmers practice NPM in 22 villages with 123.5 acres of land



56 women got benefitted and Covid -19 related job work, stitching over 13506 face masks and household garments. *Training centre support to Scouts and Guides, Guntur, GoAP.*



Over 3000 saplings both fruit bearing and non-fruit bearing planted in the targeted villages



Veterinary healthcare services extended to over 16578 animals which includes cows, sheep's, buffaloes, goats etc in the targeted villages

The Late Nannapaneni Lokadityudu and Sita Ravamma Comprehensive Natco Cancer Centre at GGH, Guntur, approved by AERB and BARC, is the state-of-the-art cancer care centre built in a spacious area of 80,000 sq. ft. which is the first of its kind Government Hospital in the State of Andhra Pradesh built with such quality and zeal matching the core corporate hospitals in the State. This is the first ever AERB approved Government Hospital in the State of Andhra Pradesh. During covid-19, the hospital has been

used to administer the covid-19 vaccination for people.

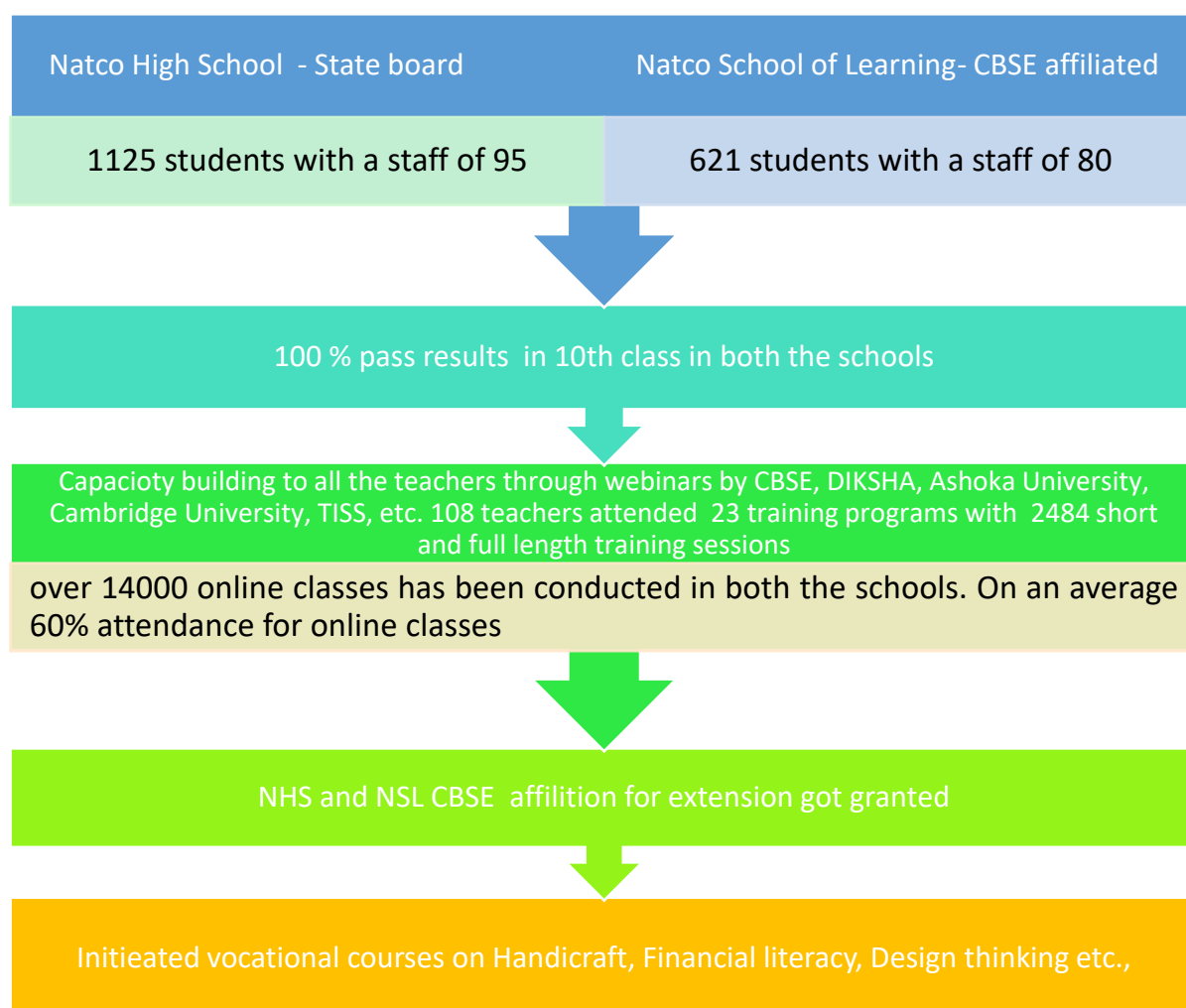
Natco nurtured schools: - Natco high school at Kothur, Ranga Reddy district and Natco school of learning at Gollamudipadu village, Guntur district has been promoted and run by Natco Trust.

NATCO HIGH SCHOOL (CBSE Syllabus): - Natco High School was established in the year 1995 under the aegis of Natco Trust, to provide education to the surrounding villages and children of employees of Natco Pharma Ltd. The journey started with 77 students, 10 classrooms and 10 staff members in 1995. **Today it has 1125 students with 95 staff members and 67 classrooms.....**

Natco School of Learning (CBSE Syllabus) established in the year 2011 at Gollamudipadu village, Ponnur Mandal of Guntur District, with an objective of providing good education to the local communities, with a strength of 156 children and 25 staff and currently it has 621 children with 80 staff members and 64 classrooms

Education: - Support to Government schools and Anganawadis

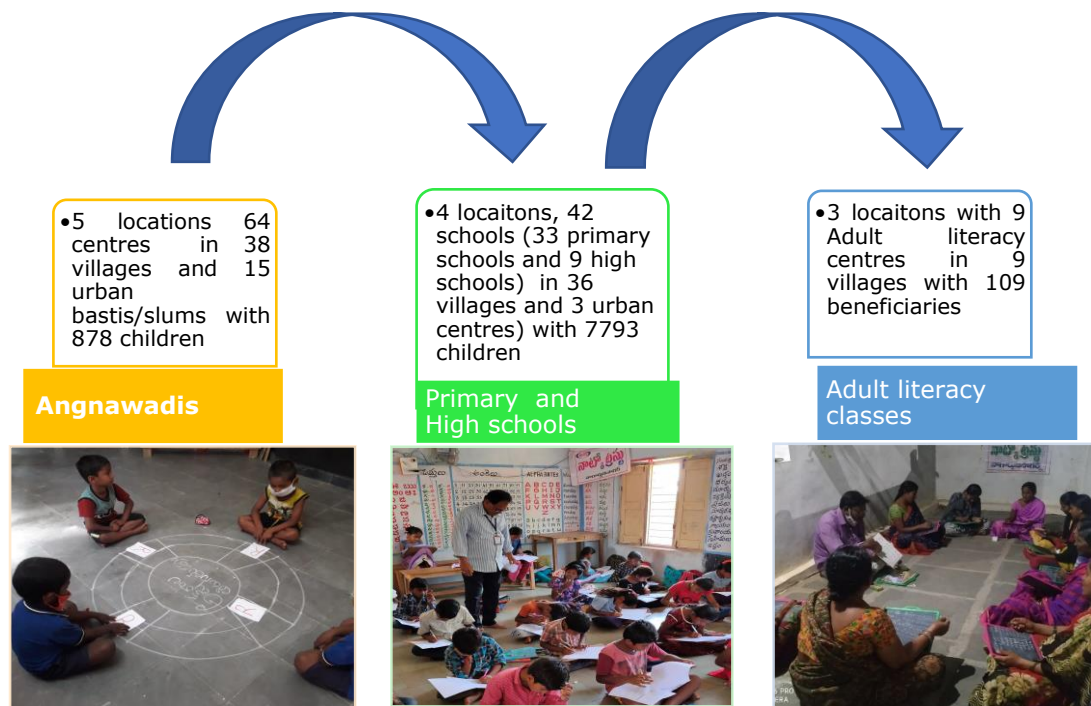
We are committed to create enabling environment for children through education initiatives, emphasis laid on access, equity and quality of education by extending the need based support on appropriate infrastructure, skilled teachers, innovative teaching methodology and curriculum, access to basic teaching learning materials for improving the learning competence of the children, in addition to this adapted innovative methods to make learning more interactive and participatory.

Objective: - To strengthen the government schools in terms of infrastructure, libraries, science labs, Vidhya volunteers etc. to retain all the eligible school going children in the school and impart qualitative education.

Natco Trust supports **42 schools and out of which high schools are Natco nurtured schools and 40 are government schools**, out of which 06 are high schools and 34 primary schools and **64 Anganawadis -AWs** (Early Childhood Education) and 9 adult literacy classes in 5 districts of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh

It is a 3-pronged support to the government, private schools and Anganwadis

1. Holistic development of children through academic support, nutritious supplementary, water and sanitation, tuitions, sports, and healthcare
2. Child centric and demand driven infrastructure support to Government schools and AWs
3. Human resources and capacity building



Due to COVID-19 PANDEMIC the schools and Anganwadis are not fully functioning, and the support has been extended in the form of online and offline classes, after school tuitions, Gurukula coaching, home visits and worksheets to the children at the doorsteps of their homes. **A total of 8780 children got benefited.**



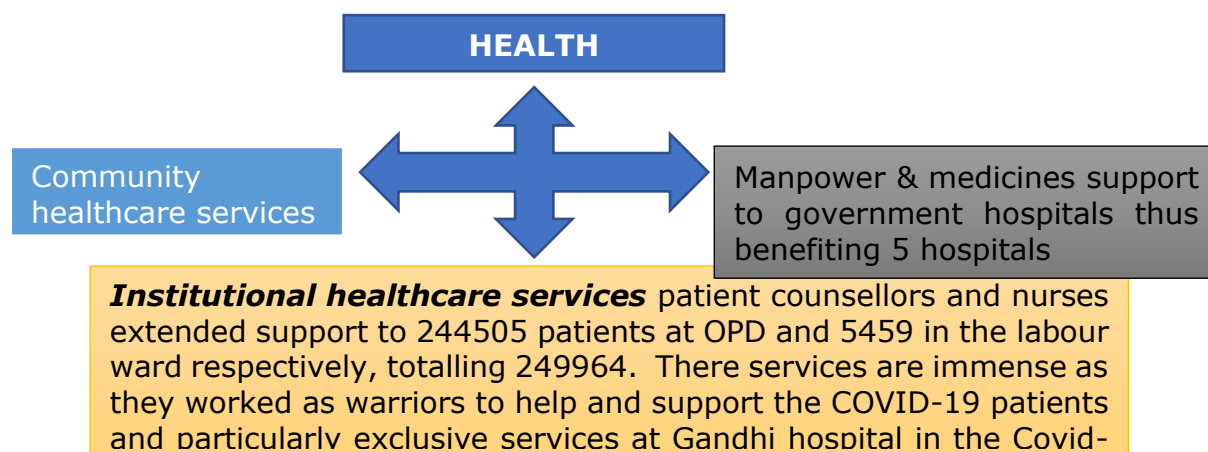
Support to Government schools and Anganwadi centres

878 children from 64 anganwadis from 38 villages and 15 urban bastis (slums) got benefited from online /offline classes, nutritional supplementaries, healthcare services, worksheets etc (able to reach 60% children). 922 home visits completed with repeated visits	239 children got benefited from gurukula coaching and 76 children secured the seats from 25 villages and 4 urban basti (slum). conducted 88 parents meeting through online and offline and attended by 1004 parents. 140 children got enrolled to grade 1 from Anganwadi centres	1960 children got benefitted from after school tuitions, online/offline classes and home visits to 977 children houses for individual education (the attendance is 50%).	a new Anganwadi construction and renovation of a government school into anganwadi centre and a new ZPH school construction under progress at Kothur location	Compound wall supported to ZPH school- Siddipet. 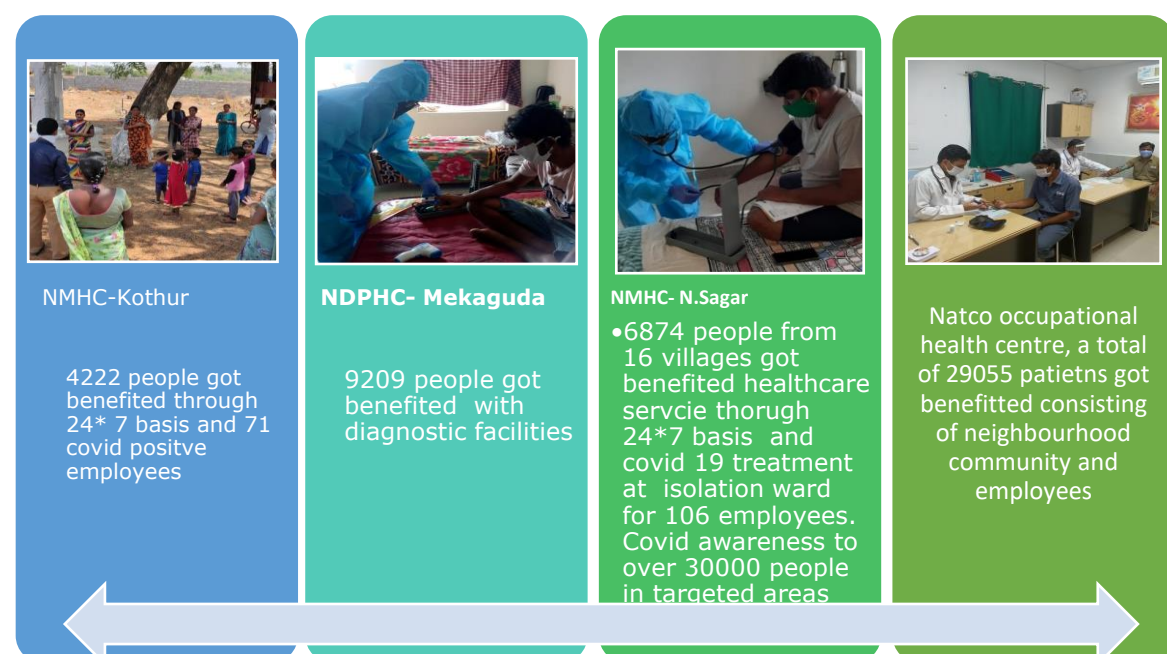

COUNSELLING AND NURSING SERVICE DETAILS....



Community outreach healthcare services: - Natco trust initiated 2 mobile health clinics and two standalone satellite clinics one for the community and the other one is occupational health centre for the employees and the neighbourhood community.

Due to COVID 19 Pandemic the mobile healthcare services are extended in offline and online mode to the villages/communities and standalone mode at respective factory locations and extended COVID-19 healthcare services to the employees and their immediate family members. A total of **49466** people got benefitted and health awareness including covid-19 awareness conducted in all targeted areas benefiting over **30000** people including children.



BLOOD DONATION CAMP ON THE EVE OF FOUNDERS DAY CELEBRATION

On Founder's Day celebration on 30th November 2020, across 10 locations of Natco group donated 913 units of blood to different blood banks and government hospitals in their respective locations including NTR Trust, Rotary club and Red cross society.

- 28 villages with 39 centres with 445 mothers (267 AN and 178 PN mothers) with a normal delivery of 94, cesarian 136, delivery at Govt hospitals are 151 and private hospital are 79

- 22 villages with 123.5 acres of land with 116 farmers including Natco supported leased farming



Vocational centre

- 13506 face masks has been stitched and distributed to the employees and the community. stitching up of children and women wear
- 56 women got benefitted



Potable water plants

- 4 Grama Panchayats with 4 habitations thus benefiting over 28000 people.



Veterinary healthcare services: - Natco trust extends fodder and medicines to cater the needs of animal husbandry in and around the villages of Nandigam and Kothur mandals of Ranga Reddy district and a total of **7081 animals got benefitted**, that includes suspected theilerioses, Diarrhoea, Mastitis, Anaemic & Inappetence, Milk Fever, Pyometra & Endometritis, ROP, Pregnancy diagnosis, Deworming, Anestrus, Calf scours, Lumpy skin disease (Viral Break Out), IV infusions of Calcium, Mg (450 ml) for animals about to parturient and after parturition based on animal condition.

Through Veterinary camps 9497 animals got benefitted in 6 villages thus benefitting 398 farmers families at Nagarjuna Sagar, Nalgonda district.



Support to Bharat Scouts and Guides: - Support of Regional training centre, Guntur GoAP

Support to Sports: - Individual Support for boxing and support to Sports Authority of Telangana for promotion of different games and sports

Youth mobilization and partner in development

3 youth groups formed/registered with 56 members and involved in the development of village and volunteering shramadhan as part of clean and green initiative by planation and cleaning the drainages



PLANTATION: - around 3000 fruit and non-fruit bearing saplings has been planted in the Anganwadis, government schools and in the targeted villages at Peddavura and Thirumalagiri mandals, Nalgonda district.
